Dragonflies Class enjoyed a wonderful visit to Roche Court Sculpture Park as part of their enrichment curriculum. The children explored a range of contemporary artworks and engaged thoughtfully with the sculptures around them. Staff reported excellent behaviour, curiosity, and some impressive artistic reflections from the pupils.

Beetles class had a valuable and meaningful trip to the Medina Mosque in Southampton, which greatly supported their learning about different beliefs and practices. The visit also helped deepen their understanding of respect for others' faiths and encouraged rich discussion around challenging what they might read about in the media.
